**ORDER APPOINTING SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATOR, APPROVING
SETTLEMENT NOTICE PROGRAM, AND COMPELLING PRODUCTION OF
CUSTOMER CONTACT INFORMATION**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Appoint Settlement Administrator, Approve Settlement Notice Program, and Compel Production of Customer Contact Information, filed June 9, 2023 (the "Motion"). The Court, having reviewed the Motion, the accompanying memorandum and papers filed therewith, and the file, hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

The Motion is hereby by **GRANTED**.

1. JND Legal Administration is hereby appointed as the Settlement Administrator with respect to the CBS, Fox, Cox Entities, and ShareBuilders Settlements.

2. The Court approves the proposed Notice Program, including the, Email Notice, Postcard Notice, Print Notice, Digital Notice, Long Form Notice and the Claim Form, attached the Declaration of Gina M. Intrepido-Bowden as Exhibits B to G.

3. Within twenty-one (21) days after entry of this Order, Defendants TEGNA, Raycom, and Meredith shall produce their customer contact information, including mailing addresses and email addresses, in a usable electronic format (*i.e.*, Excel), to the extent they are reasonably accessible.

4. Within forty-five (45) days after entry of this Order, the Settlement Administrator shall cause the Email Notice and Postcard Notice to be disseminated to Settlement Class members in accordance with the Notice Program and shall activate the Settlement Website (where the Long-Form Notice shall be posted) and Toll-Free Number.

5. Within forty-five (45) days after entry this Order, or as soon as practicable thereafter due to publication schedules, the Settlement Administrator shall cause the Print and Digital Notices to be published in accordance with the Notice Program. The Digital Notice shall be published for four (4) weeks.

6. Within 75 days after entry of this Order, Plaintiffs shall file their motion for attorneys' fees and expense reimbursement.

7. Within 90 days after entry of this Order, Plaintiffs shall file their motion for final approval of the Settlements.

8. Any objections to the Settlements or requests for exclusion therefrom must be postmarked by 105 days after entry of this Order.

9. At least seven (7) days before the Final Approval Hearing, Plaintiffs shall file their responses to objections, if any, and a proposed final approval order with a complete list of all Settlement Class Members that have opted out of the Settlements.

10. The Court shall hold a Final Approval Hearing on October 17, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., which is at least 120 days after entry of this Order. The Court may order the Final Approval Hearing to be postponed, adjourned, or continued. If that occurs, the updated hearing date shall be posted on the Settlement Website. Other than the website posting, the Parties will not be required to provide any additional notice to Settlement Class Members. Pursuant to any applicable orders, the Final Approval Hearing may take place remotely, including via telephone or video conference.
